Bishop Farrell has written to remind parishioners that it is possible to attend Mass on a weekday morning. This will help with the restriction of numbers which is in place. The obligation to attend Mass has been and continues to be suspended at this time.

Visitation of the housebound on First Friday and the visitation and celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick will not normally take place at this time.

Plans to celebrate First Holy Communion and Confirmation will be put in place later in the summer when we will have a better picture of what will be possible.

Bishop Farrell concludes that "the corona virus is a shared harm, a 'common bad' that threatens every member of our community...by every person accepting their responsibility we can protect people's health and save lives. As the posters remind us – we are in this together".
