Baptisms


Bishop Nulty has informed us that the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism is possible at this time. Please contact the Parish Office to make arrangements.

Three elements, the silhouetted church, the cross and St Kieran with the Pillar, are incorporated in the logo emphasising the parochial, diocesan and historical importance of St Mary's Cathedral in the city of Kilkenny and the Diocese of Ossory.

The Tower of St Mary's stands proud over the city of Kilkenny. Here, presented in silhouette, it is a familiar landmark which can be seen from many parts of Kilkenny City.

St Kieran traditionally is represented between two pillars which signify the City of Kilkenny. The mitred abbot holds the episcopal crozier and draws us outward to the 42 parishes of our diocese.

The Cross is etched on a funereal tombstone in Saighir Kieran, the cradle of the diocese, where St Kieran's bell rang and prompted him to establish his monastery. From Saighir the faith spread throughout the kingdom of Ossory.
