Wedneday – Ash Wednesday

Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and the first day of Lent. It is a day of Fast and Abstinence. On the day in the readings there is an awareness of our sinfulness, as we pray 'Have mercy on us, O Lord, for we have sinned'. There is also a sense that the time to repent and turn back to the Lord is now. The gospel puts before us three ways to renew our lives: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. These three strands of Lenten observances are as ancient as Christianity itself. "Fasting is the soul of prayer, mercy is the lifeblood of fasting. If we have not all three together, we have nothing" St Peter Chyrsologus.
