JUNE: THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART

June traditionally has been the month of the Sacred Heart. During this month we will pray the Divine Praises at Mass. In the cathedral – in the south transept – there is the beautiful window of the Sacred Heart and Sr Margaret Mary Alacoque. This window dates from the mid 1880s. C 1886 a very severe storm destroyed the original window, and it was replaced by the window of the Sacred Heart. This stained-glass window is the work of Mayer and Co Munich, well known stained glass artists. From this company also came the statue of the Blessed Virgin in the Lady Chapel. The altar of the Sacred Heart is the work of James Pearse – father of Patrick and William Pearse. It is highly probable that the statue was imported from Italy, but the altar and mosaic work is that of Pearse. On the opposite wall is the large oil painting of the revelations to Sr Margaret Mary Alacoque and from whom the devotion to the Sacred Heart is attributed. The large oil painting is in a frame design by William Hague. Hague was commissioned by Bishop Brownrigg for the works undertaken in the 1890s...
