Easter Ceremonies

As you are aware this Easter RTE will broadcast the Easter Ceremonies from our Cathedral, live on Good Friday at 3pm and for the Easter Vigil at 11pm on Holy Saturday night. Again, we thank all those who are working to prepare for these celebrations. We are delighted that the people of St Canice's Parish have opted to join us for the Vigil on that night. We will make them welcome. We will also be joined by the Dominicans and the Capuchins. These promise to be special celebrations - resist the temptation to sit and watch them from home. Please come to join us.

Altar Pieces

Displayed in the Sacristy corridor are copper reliefs, the work of Irish artist Edward Delaney in 1972. The longer reliefs adorned the black Kilkenny marble altar which stood in the Cathedral following the renovations in the years after the Second Vatican Council. They depict stories from the New Testament : the Flight into Egypt; the Annunciation; the Birth of Christ; the Baptism of Christ; the Miraculous Draught of Fishes; the Healing of the Sick; the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem; the Last Supper; the Meeting of Martha and Mary; the Resurrection; Crucifixion and the Ascension. The shorter pieces were on the Ambo from that time - they depict the Gospel of the Sower and a local scene of a hanging here in Kilkenny. People who were condemned were held in the Court House overnight and refused a visit of a priest for Confession. However, tradition has it that the priest would go to Rothe House and from an upper window offer absolution to those facing execution.
