This year the celebration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday and the celebration of the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night were both televised on RTE from St Mary's Cathedral. It was after the initial yes to say that we were willing to make them welcome that the work in earnest started. Sean O'Neill and Joy Bibby began immediately with the Cathedral Choir and a few male voices that were added to their ranks to choose music for the two celebrations. Choosing the music was only the beginning - from then countless hours of practice were needed to ensure the choir were, as they always are, in such fine voice adding wonderfully to this celebration as they do to all celebrations in St Mary's. Each piece of music had then to be timed so as to ensure that a detailed running order for each celebration could be planned.

The liturgies themselves had then to be scripted. Each word that was to be spoken had to be written and, like the music, timed. All those who would fulfil the various ministries at these celebrations had to be chosen and undertake practices, and then there was visits from various technicians and the crews who would be filming it, a day of pre-recorded shots and audio for the opening credits, and all of this in the midst of the normal Lenten activities that are part of the life of the Cathedral and Diocese.

All of this was enjoyable, and worthwhile - after all we are getting a chance to invite people from all around Ireland into our beautiful Cathedral Parish for two most holy and sacred celebrations. It was a chance to bring Christ to those who will follow on TV or Radio in those days. We are called to proclaim Christ so why would we say anything but yes to this opportunity and this great experience. A sincere thank you to all who made this happen.
