A thought... This past week we celebrated the Feast day of St Ita who was known as the Brigid of Munster. She was a Saint in Waterford and earned herself the reputation of the Foster Mother of all the Saints of Ireland. She was baptised as Deidre but became known as Ita as a result of her "thirst for holiness". That search for holiness took her to Killeedy, where it seems a chieftain offered her a large grant of land to support her convent. But Ita only accepted four acres, which she cultivated instantly - and there founded a school which had among its students a young St Brendan the Navigator. We have a rich tradition of Saints in Ireland - does it continue?
